

Baby Panda

Crochet Pattern Written by Melissa's Crochet Patterns



You will need...

- Yarn Color A (Red Heart Super Saver Solids in White)
- Yarn Color B (Loops & Threads Impeccable Brights in Lippy)
- Fiberfill Stuffing
- Stitch Markers
- 12mm Safety Eyes (or desired)
- 3.25mm crochet hook (Size D)
- Yarn Needle
- Sewing pins (optional for holding pieces in place before sewing)

Stitches and Abbreviations used...

- Ch - chain
- Sl - slip stitch
- Sc - single crochet
- St - stitch
- Sts - stitches
- Rpt - repeat
- Inc - increase, 2 sc in the same space
- Dec - decrease or sc2tog (single crochet 2 together)

Tip - The head consists of a lot of color changes. I recommend cutting and tying

after every color change so your crochet doesn't get too pulled and warped.
After Rnd 10 of these colors changes, you can cut all the tails so you don't see other colors peeking through your white yarn.



Note : All pieces are made in a continuous spiral. Most pieces begin with a magic ring, but you can also use a ch 2 to start.

Head

- Using Yarn Color A

Rnd 1 ~ Using a magic ring, place 6 sc into the magic ring (6 sc)

Rnd 2 ~ inc around (12 sc)

Rnds 3-4 ~ sc around (12 sc)

Rnd 5 ~ sc in 3, inc / rpt around (15 sc)

Rnd 6 ~ sc in 4 -

Change to Yarn Color B - inc in each of the next 3 sts

Change to Yarn Color A - inc in the next st

Change to Yarn Color B - inc in each of the next 3 sts

Change to Yarn Color A - sc in the last 4 sts

(22 sc)

Rnd 7 ~ Continuing in Yarn Color A - sc in 5

Change to Yarn Color B - sc in 5

Change to Yarn Color A - sc in 2

Change to Yarn Color B - sc in 5

Change to Yarn Color A - sc in 5

(22 sc)

- You are done using Yarn Color B on the head.

Rnds 8-10 ~ sc around (22 sc)

Rnd 11 ~ sc in 2, dec / rpt around, dec (16 sc)

- Insert eyes between Rnds 6&7

- Stuff head, add more stuffing as needed.

Rnd 12 ~ sc in 2, dec / rpt around (12 sc)

Rnd 13 ~ dec around (6 sc)

- Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing.

- Using your yarn needle, sew the remaining hole closed.

Body

- Using Yarn Color A

Rnd 1 ~ Using a magic ring, place 6 sc into the magic ring (6 sc)

Rnd 2 ~ inc around (12 sc)

Rnd 3 ~ sc, inc / rpt around (18 sc)

Rnd 4 ~ sc in 2 sts, inc / rpt around (24 sc)

Rnd 5 ~ sc around (24 sc)

Rnd 6 ~ sc in 10, dec / rpt (22 sc)

Rnd 7 ~ sc in 9, dec / rpt (20 sc)

Rnd 8 ~ sc in 8, dec / rpt (18 sc)

- Change to Yarn Color B (You are done using Yarn Color A).

Rnds 9-10 ~ sc around (18 sc)

Rnd 11 ~ sc in 7, dec / rpt (16 sc)

Rnd 12 ~ sc in 2, dec / rpt around (12 sc)

- Sl in the next st.
- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.
- Stuff body.
- With your yarn needle, and tail from the body, sew the head and body together.

Arms (make 2)

- Using Yarn Color B

Rnd 1 ~ Using a magic ring, place 5 sc into the magic ring (5 sc)

Rnd 2 ~ inc around (10 sc)

Rnds 3-4 ~ sc around (10 sc)

Rnd 5 ~ sc in 3, dec / rpt (8 sc)

- Stuff hand, do not stuff the rest of the arm.

Rnd 6 ~ sc in 2, dec / rpt (6 sc)

Rnds 7-10 ~ sc around (6 sc)

Rnd 11 ~ ch 1, fold in half, crocheting through both sides at the same time, sc across (3 sc)

- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.
- Using your yarn needle and the tail, sew the arms to the side of the body, right under the head.

Legs (make 2)

- Using Yarn Color B

Rnd 1 ~ Using a magic ring, place 6 sc into the magic ring (6 sc)

Rnd 2 ~ inc around (12 sc)

Rnds 3-4 ~ sc around (12 sc)

Rnd 5 ~ sc in 4, dec / rpt (10 sc)

Rnd 6 ~ sc in 3, dec / rpt (8 sc)

- Stuff foot, do not stuff the rest of the leg.

Rnds 7-9 ~ sc around (8 sc)

Rnd 10 ~ ch 1, fold in half, crocheting through both sides at the same time, sc across (4 sc)

- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.
- Using your yarn needle and the tail, sew the legs onto the bottom of the body.

Ears (make 2)

- Using Yarn Color B
- Do not stuff

Rnd 1 ~ Using a magic ring, place 6 sc into the magic ring (6 sc)

Rnd 2 ~ sc in 2, inc / rpt (8 sc)

Rnd 3 ~ ch 1, fold in half, crocheting through both sides at the same time, sc across (4 sc)

- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.
- With your yarn needle and tail, sew the ears onto the head.

Tail

- Using Yarn Color B

Rnd 1 ~ Using a magic ring, place 6 sc into the magic ring (6 sc)

Rnd 2 ~ sc in 2, inc / rpt (8 sc)

Rnd 3 ~ sc around (8 sc)

- Sl in next st.
- Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing.
- Stuff tail.
- Using your yarn needle, sew the tail onto the bottom of the back.

Using your yarn needle and Yarn Color B, embroider your Baby Panda a nose.
